

Parent Guide to Rainy Day Eating at Kensington

In order to keep students and staff safe on days when there is rain, and still have COVID protocols in place, the following measures will be implemented:

WHEN STUDENTS ARE EATING OR DRINKING THEY MUST:

- Be airplane arms apart
- Be seated
- Face the same direction
- Put their mask on if standing for any reason

ALSO:

- All classrooms have new WINIX D360 Air Purifiers
- There are multiple WINIX D360 Air Purifiers in the cafeteria
- All classes maintain their eating protocols in the cafeteria in that they stay seated with their same class during this time.

Snack Eating Plan	
K-3	Shifts: -Half of the class has read-aloud or other academic activity on carpet, the other half of the students eat snack with mask off spread out on other side of

	<p>the room - 3 feet distance, all facing same direction.</p> <p>Switch.</p> <p>These snack times may occur at teacher discretion, prior to the indoor recess, or after the indoor recess, as teacher sees fit.</p> <p>Students in grades 1-3 who eat school-provided snack can come to the cafeteria for their snack and eat it in the cafeteria. This will occur during their indoor recess time. They will sit 3 feet apart, all facing the same direction.</p>
4-6	<p>-Half of the class eats snacks in the room - spaced 3 feet apart facing the same direction, the other half go to the cafeteria for a teacher supervised spaced apart snack.</p> <p>This snack occurs from 10:20 - 10:30, prior to the start of the indoor recess.</p> <p>Students in grades 4-6 who eat school-provided snack can come to the cafeteria for their snack and eat it in the cafeteria. They will sit 3 feet apart, all facing the same direction.</p>

Lunch Eating Plan

Kinder	<p>Students eat lunch spaced out in the classroom in 2 shifts - as stated in snack protocol.</p> <p>Students who get school lunch, walk to the cafeteria to get lunches, then return to the classroom.</p>
1-3	<p>Half of the class eats lunch in the classroom, the other half goes to the cafeteria for a principal/adult supervised spaced apart lunch.</p> <p>Classroom supervision is provided by roving volunteers.</p>
4-6	<p>Half of the class eats lunch in the classroom, the other half goes to the cafeteria for a principal / adult supervised spaced apart lunch.</p> <p>Classroom supervision is provided by roving volunteers.</p>
